3. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the following rules:

1. The racing rules of sailing RRS 2009-2012 ISAF, including the additional prescriptions of Swiss Sailing
2. The Esse 850 class rules
3. Swiss federal law for inland navigation with local amendments will apply

4. Eligibility

The regatta is open to boats from all countries. Participants must be member of the Esse 850 international Class and member of a sailing club affiliated to ISAF. For Swiss competitors the amendments of Swiss Sailing to the eligibility code will apply.

5. Advertising

This event is a category C event (valid license necessary).

6. Entry procedure and entry fee

Entries and payments shall be received by the organizing committee no later than Avril 10, 2010

A late inscription with supplementary fee at the Club on April 30 is possible.

The following documents are necessary for the registration:

- Copy of the measurement certificate or certificate of conformity
- Confirmation of club membership or license
- Advertising license if applicable.
- Confirmation of third-party liability insurance

The entry fee is Chf 250.- per boat (including dinner cost, without drink).

The supplementary entry fee for late entries is CHF 50.-

7. Race program

April 30

- o 16.00 -19.00 registration, crew weight in (max 280Kg),
- o 19.30 aperitif offer by Société Nautique de Genève – cercle de la voile

May 1

- o 9.00 skipper-meeting
- o 10.00 first warning signal, see notice board
- o A dinner is planned at the Société nautique de Genève for the evening (including in the entry fees)

May 2

- o 8h30 skipper meeting
- o 9.00 first warning signal, see notice board
- o 16:00 last possible warning signal

A maximum of 8 races are scheduled.

8. Measurement

All boats must have a valid and complete measurement certificate.

9. Scoring

The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will be applying (Sailing RRS 2009-2012 ISAF).
With 5 to 8 valid races, the worst result will be eliminated.

10. Prizes

There will be championship prizes for the first five boats.

11. Mooring and parking

For every boat a suitable place will be provided in the harbor of Société Nautique de Genève
Special parking lots will be assigned to the trailers.
There will be a designated parking area for cars close to the harbor.

12. Support boats

Support boats must register at the race committee before the beginning of the event and comply with all instructions given by the race committee.
Support boats will be part of the security arrangement for the event.

13. Social events

The Club will organize the following social events:

- Thursday, April 30: cocktail in Société nautique de Genève
- Saturday, Mai 1: official dinner in Société nautique de Genève (to be confirm with the entrie)

14. Liability and insurance

Competitors participate at the regatta entirely at their own risk (see RRS rule 4 - Decision to race).
The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
Each participating boat shall be insured by valid third-party liability insurance with adequate cover per event and valid for racing.
